## PROPOSED CAPITAL PROJECTS

The budget season has started at the Honolulu City Council and is in full swing of being reviewed and prepared for hearings that commenced this past March and will conclude in June 2011. The operating, legislative and capital budgets; and the real property tax rate will be set during this process and is effective starting July 1<sup>st</sup> 2011. As the Council continues to wrestle with the budget and while there has been talk of cuts to stave off increases in taxes, I did not hesitate to move forward with various capital improvement project proposals that I felt was necessary for Council District 3. Following are the projects that my office has submitted for approval:

\$50,000—Kailua Supplemental Traffic Analysis: Planning and Design funding will enable the City to conduct studies necessary to develop a comprehensive assessment of current traffic patterns and volumes within the general urban area of Kailua.

\$100,000—Guardrail improvements at various locations in Waimanalo: Design, construction and inspection funds were proposed for guardrails in various areas of Waimanalo due to the numerous streets that run parallel to open ditches and due to the lack of curbing; in addition, this would curtail the illegal dumping of vehicles.

\$50,000—Kailua Beach Park Restroom Construction: Funding for planning and design of a new restroom facility at Kailua Beach Park. This facility is nearing the end of its usable life.

While the following projects are not new, and because focusing on our aging infrastructure is of great importance to me, I will encourage my colleagues to maintain the following items that are currently on the Capital Improvement Projects Bill 14 (2011):

\$210,000—Kaneohe Bay #2 Wastewater Pump Station Force Main: Funds will enable the City to acquire land, plan and design force main improvements.

\$351,000—Kaneohe Bay #3 Wastewater Pump Station Force Main: to plan and design force main improvements.

\$3.7million—Kaneohe/Kailua Force Main No. 2: this is to acquire land, plan, de-

\$510,000—Kawa Stream and Ditch Improvements
